THE UNIVERSITIES ACT, No. 16 OF 1978

Ordinance

- This Ordinance may be cited as the Campus Board Ordinance No. 3 of 1995 and shall come into force upon its publication in the *Gazette*.
 - (1) The Campus Board (hereinafter referred to as "The Board") shall consist of the following:-
 - the Rector of the Campus;
 - the Dean of each Faculty of the Campus;
 - the Heads of each Department of Study of the Campus;
 - two members elected by the members of the Senate of the University to which the Campus is attached from among themselves; and
 - two members appointed by the Council of the University to which the Campus is attached from among persons who have rendered distinguished service in the various disciplines of studies imparted at the Campus.
 - (2) A member elected under sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph 2 or a member appointed under sub-paragraph (e) of paragraph 2 shall, unless he vacates his office earlier, hold office for a period of three years reckoned from the date of his election or appointment, as the case may be, and shall be eligible for re-election or re-appointment as the case may be.

Provided that, an elected member shall hold office as long as he is a member of the Senate of the University by virtue of which he was eligible for election as a member of the Board.
 - (3) Where any appointed or elected member vacates office prior to the expiry of his term, his successor shall, unless he vacates office earlier, hold office for the unexpired part of the term of office of the member whom he succeeds.
 - (4) Any appointed or elected member of the Board may resign his office by a letter in that behalf addressed to the Vice-Chancellor of the University to which such Campus is attached.
 - (5) The quorum for any meeting of the Board shall be one-third of its total membership.
 - (6) The Rector of the Campus shall preside at all meetings of the Board. Where the Rector is unable to preside at any meeting of the Board the members present at such meeting shall elect from among themselves a member to preside at such meeting.
3. The "Campus Board Ordinance, No. 3 of 1979" published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 55/26 of 28th September, 1979 is hereby repealed.
